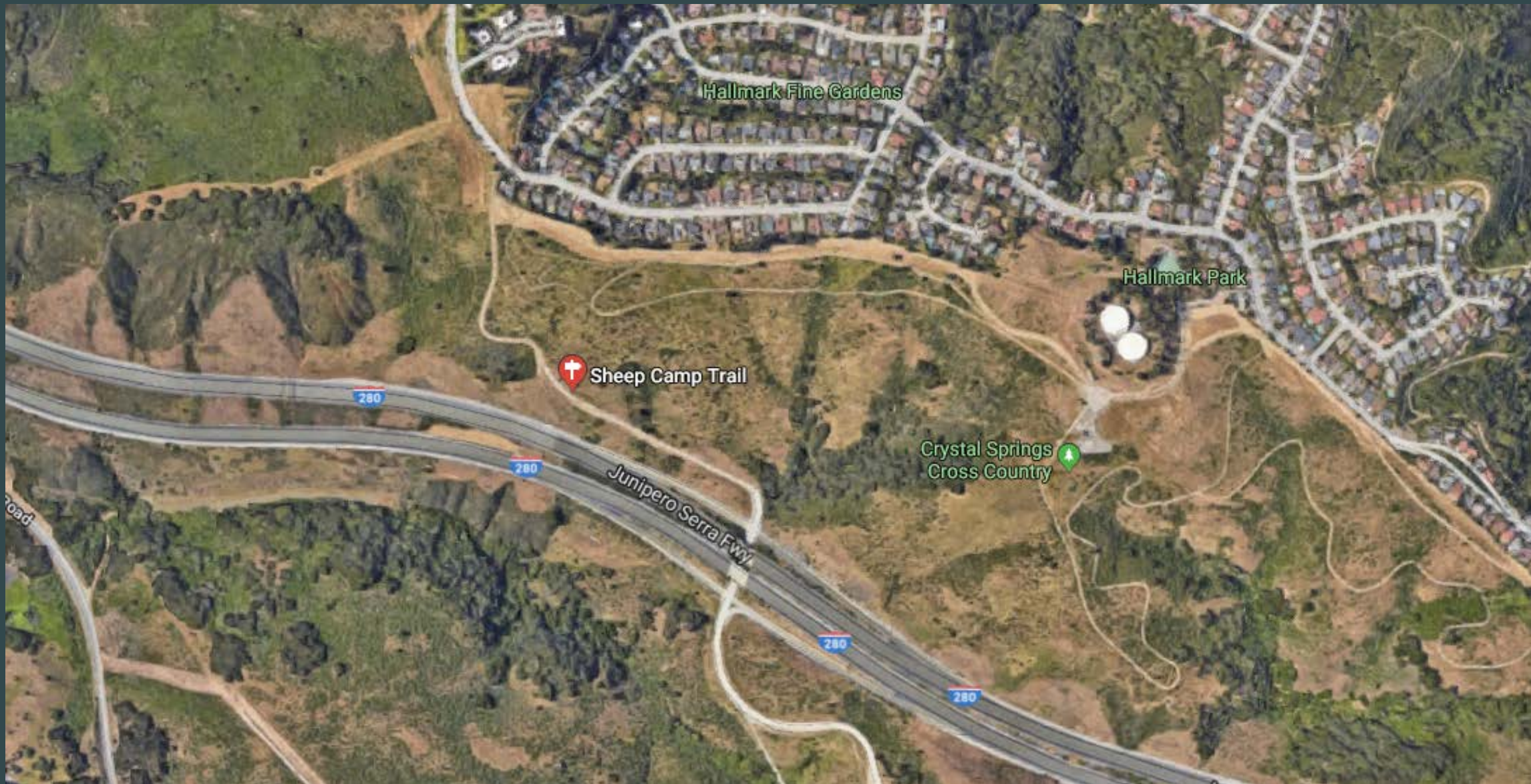

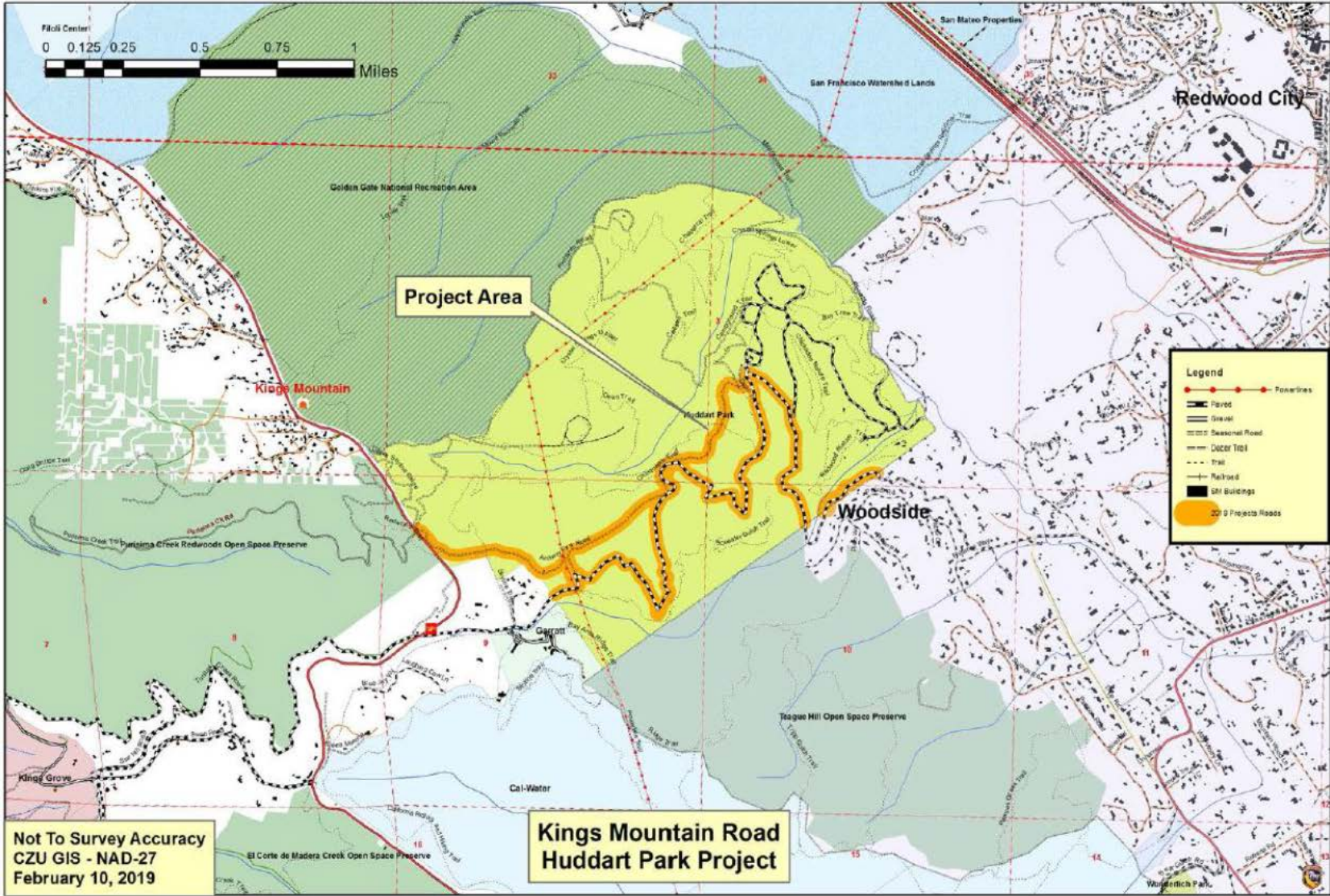

KINGS MOUNTAIN PROJECT IMPLEMENTATION

- CAL FIRE - Lead Agency
- CONTRACTORS – Implementation
 - Heavy equipment
 - Hand work
- PARK Rangers/Staff – Coordination
 - On-site



KINGS MOUNTAIN PROJECT – ROAD AND PARK ACCESS

- Project Timeframe: August 19 - October
- Road/Trail Closures: Monday through Friday
 - Archery Fire Road: August 19 – 23
 - Kings Mountain Road: Begins August 26
 - Park Trail Status - Posted in Park
